# <u>DID YOU KNOW?</u>

#### 1) **SCC Membership**:

for 1999 – 2000 club year - **118 Members** ( as of September 1, 1999 ).

## 2) SCC 1999 – 2000 Club Championship:

- changed from last year's round-robin groupings, to a **Swiss,** in **two sections**.
- top section eligibility low cut-off rating will be 2000.
- because of SCC's "special "short term memberships policy, the **Club Champion** will be the highest placing "annual "member.

### 3) <u>Joint Club Membership</u>:

- new / renewal members seeking to join either **the ScarboroughCC** or **the Dutton CC** can take out memberships simultaneously in each club at a discount.
- may provide flexibility for some members because the two clubs operate on different days SCC : Tues., Thurs. & Sun.; DCC : Mon., Wed. & Sat.

#### 4) A Special SCC Tournament :

- the SCC Championship is the longest multi-week tournament run annually by SCC 8 rounds
- lots of chance to make up for losses in early rounds; ensures that the winner will have to have played a number of other top finishers to get to the top
- leads to a number of strong contests in later rounds, which member / non-member non-players may wish to come and watch .

#### 5) SCC Evening "Speed "Tournaments:

- a **15-min**. 6-round tournament each Tues. at 7:30 p.m.
- a **5- min. blitz** double 7-round tournament each Sun. at 5:00 p.m.
- open to both members and non-members ( no guest fee for non-members )
- top half: 1<sup>st</sup>&2<sup>nd</sup> place money prize; lower half: 1<sup>st</sup> place money prize (where 8 players or more)
- SCC members' results posted on the bulletin board each week
- SCC ratings for both members & non-members updated weekly.

## 6) SCC Membership Base

- very balanced as to strength levels:

"A"/"B"/ "C[ top ½ ]" ( 1500-1999 )

"Master"/"Candidate Master"/"Expert" ( 2000 & Over )

"C [bottom ½ ]"/"D" & Under/Unrated ( Under 1500 )

- 23 %
