Prague Unity Agreement – More Conflict / Confusion

Just when we thought things were clarifying, we have now taken a step backwards. On the FIDE side of the draw, Ruslan Ponomariov having defaulted in signing the conditions of the match, it appears now that Kasparov will play the winner of the next knockout round of the FIDE world championship. This is to be played in Oct. / Nov. of this year.

FIDE had also announced that it was now organizing the Vladimir Kramnik – Peter Leko match, and set the site as Buenos Aires, since Einstein TV, which had held the rights to the match had gone bankrupt. But recently Kramnik took to the airwaves and announced that he had taken back the rights to arranging a challenge match, and had not given it over to FIDE. Moreover he said he was negotiating with a sponsor.

This once again puts the Kramnik-Leko match up in the air. Can the Prague Unity Agreement survive all the twisting and turning that's taking place in its name ??

SCC held its annual general meeting on Thursday, Sept. 4. The Executive elected for the 2003-2004 year are :

Our rent at Stan Wadlow Park Clubhouse has now been raised to \$66 from \$44 for Thursday night, and to \$88 from \$44 for Sunday afternoon.
