Anand Wins FIDE Rapid World Championship

This FIDE-authorized world championship took place Oct. 24 – 30 at Cap D’Agde, France. Time control is 25 min. with 10 sec. increments per move. It started with two groups of 8, and included 11 of the 12 top players in the world (Kasparov didn’t play, though he is a previous champion). Each group played a round robin, and the top 4 finishers then proceeded to the knockout phase of the tournament. The first group, and its first 4 finishers, was : V. Kramnik; R. Ponomariov; E. Bacrot; V. Topalov; B. Gelfand; E. Bareev; Z. Armaiparashvili; and M. Adams. The second group, and its top 4 finishers, was : P. Svidler; A. Grischuk; V. Anand; J. Polgar; A. Shirov; J Lautier; P. Leko; and A. Karpov.

The quarter final winners were : Kramnik (over Polgar); Anand (over Ponomariov); Grischuk (over Bacrot) ; Svidler (over Topalov).

The semi-final winners were : Kramnik (over Grischuk); Anand (over Svidler).

In the final knockout match, Anand defeated Kramnik 1.5 : .5.

Sunday meeting time. Instead we will open on Tuesday evenings. So we will still offer 2 meetings per week. We look forward to moving to our new, more affordable, premises.

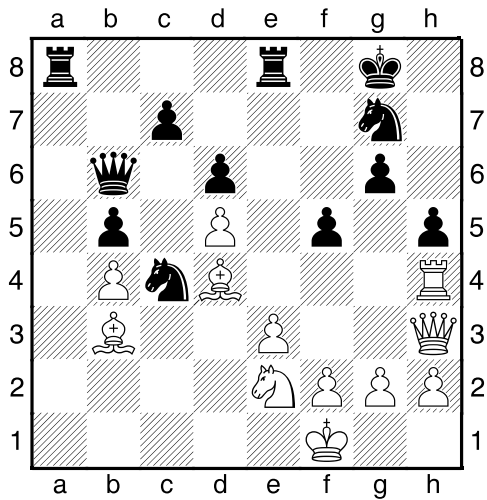
