This tournament will take place July 2,3,4 at Tartu College (one block east of Spadina on the north side of Bloor.) It is a five round tournament (rounds 6 pm, 10 am, 4pm, 10am, 4pm) Time control is 40/2 hrs, game/30). It will be played as one section but prizes and final round pairings will be by rating class (open, under 2200.) Players with ratings under 2200 are eligible only for under 2200 prizes except that they may by 3:15 pm July 4 opt in writing to be eligible for open prizes in which case only their 4 round point total will count toward the under 2200 prizes and they will be paired with the players competing for open prizes. For rounds 1 and 2 Jaeger acceleration will be used. Online ratings as of June15 will be used. Half point byes are available in rounds 1-4.

The prize fund will be aggregate entry fees (the \$40 and the \$50) minus \$6/player. All prizes will be paid by mail with cheques in the mail by July 7. A tournament report will be available to all by email. All advance entry fees are to be made by cheque payable to Martin Jaeger, with a \$20 fee for returned cheque. The entry fee is as follows—by mail post marked by June 24 and at site July 1- \$40. Other entries including on site after July 1- \$50. On site July 2 or 3 entries will start play at about 30 minutes after round start with a reduced first round time control.

All entrants must be or become members of the Chess Federation of Canada or payable CFC tournament membership fee of \$10. Entrants are to provide with their entry a photocopy of a current CFC membership, or include CFC membership dues or a \$10/tournament membership fee with their entry. Non complying entries will not be processed. Players who include the \$10 tournament CFC membership fee will have it refunded at the tournament upon providing proof of CFC membership.

A spectator fee of \$5/day or \$10/tournament will apply and all funds so raised will be given to the Olympiad fund.
