Annual Meeting Motions

Motion 89-25 (as amended): That the Chess Federation of Canada increase the current rating fee of \$1 per player per tournament to \$2 per player per tournament.

Motion 89-22 (as amended): That the Chess Federation of Canada will recognize as an option the use of FIDE Active Chess rules;

otherwise, the CFC rules currently in effect will be used.

Motion 89-26 (as amended): That Stephen Ball be appointed a Governor-at-Large for a term of five years, commencing with the termination of his employment with the Chess Federation of Canada.

Motion 90-1: That the CFC Executive shall spare no efforts to obtain a meaningful contribution from the FQE to help offset the international obligations of the CFC; if no signed agreement is available for presentation in Governors Letter #2, 1990, Motion 89-19 will expire on November 30, 1990 and the Executive shall present a suitable motion to the Governors for consideration at that time, based on 0% financing.

Motion 90-2: That the Participating Membership fee be reduced from \$10 to \$7, effective September 1, 1989.

Motion 90-3: That the CFC shall pay half of the outstanding amounts still owing to the prizewinners from the 1987 Canadian Open who replied to an inquiry from the CFC, excluding M. Beaubien who accepted an offer of goods instead of cash from the organizer.

3. Required CFC and Provincial membership fees must be collected, and receipts given out. (Write for a free sample registration form.) By using carbon paper, the registration form can double as a receipt. Most of the information can be filled in by the players themselves, thereby speeding registration.
4. **Submitting CFC Memberships**
 Membership report forms are available free from the CFC Business Office. When you submit memberships, please include:
 - (a) CFC membership number. If the player has been a member before, but his number is not available, put an M.
 - (b) Surname and complete given name (initials are insufficient).
 - (c) Complete address, including Postal Code, if possible, even if the address is not a new one.
 - (d) Birthdate if junior.
 - (e) Changes of address, if any.
 - (f) Your name and address and the dates of collection.
 - (g) A cheque or money order payable to the CFC.

FIDE News from Puerto Rico

CFC FIDE Representative N.Divinsky provided information from the August FIDE Congress.

Interzonal

This will be a Swiss tournament with 64 players. Spain may bid to hold it — they have an option until mid-September 1989.

The top eleven finishers in the Interzonal will go forward to the Candidates Matches (together with those placing second, third and fourth in the previous Candidates Matches). This will be followed by seven matches. The seven winners will be joined by the loser of the world title match: they will play elimination matches to select the new challenger.

Kevin Spraggett is seeded into the Interzonal and Canada will also have its regular Zonal place. This will necessitate a match between Leon Piasetski and Bryon Nickoloff, who tied for second in the Zonal.

Québec

FIDE has not yet received the full 5000 Swiss Francs for the Yusupov - Spraggett match held in Québec City. FIDE depends on revenue from such events to finance its programs. FIDE President Florencio Campomanes was quite irate about the fact that the Fédération québécoise des échecs (FQE) had not paid the balance, and urged CFC delegate Nathan Divinsky to prod the government in Québec to give the money to the FQE so that they in turn could pay FIDE. FIDE also had concerns about rating one or more Québec tournaments.

World Championship 1990

The semi-finals (Karpov vs Yusupov and Timman vs Spelman) will be held in London England beginning October 2. The final will also be held in London, starting march 7, 1990. The title match is scheduled to be held in October 1990.

There were two bids for the Title match: Wellington New Zealand and Lyon France were the contenders, both being in the neighbourhood of \$2,000,000. The New Zealand bid had a condition that Kasparov be present to defend his title — it had been reported that he might not do so if Florencio Campomanes remained President of FIDE — whereas the French bid was unrestricted. From FIDE's point of view, the French bid was excellent: the money was on the table. New Zealand had a

government guarantee, but a new PM had been elected prior to the FIDE Congress. Furthermore, with the continuing problems between Kasparov and Campomanes, there is no certainty that Kasparov will defend the title, in which case the status of the New Zealand bid would be unclear. In any case, FIDE would be in a very difficult bargaining position with Kasparov, since he could at any time simply refuse to play and thereby nullify the bid.

With this in mind, rumour has it that Campomanes put pressure on the New Zealand delegate to withdraw the bid. In the midst of a debate as to whether or not Campomanes should discuss the site selection with the reigning World Champion (which is "customary, courteous and desirable": Nathan Divinsky), the New Zealand bid was withdrawn and the New Zealand delegate congratulated France! Lyon was chosen as the site, despite the urging of Bessel Kok and Boris Spassky that the matter first be discussed with Kasparov. It will be interesting to see what Kasparov does!

Prior to this dramatic debate, new rules were introduced for the World Title Match to ensure a match would take place, even if the World Champion refused to defend his title. The procedure is that FIDE will simply go down the rating list until two players are found who will agree to play.

Code of Ethics

FIDE has been working on a Code of Ethics, which has generated considerable controversy. Two of the most heavily debated clauses were deleted, but some delegates felt that the entire ethics code structure was unnecessary — the few remaining items such as bribery and the selling of points could have been legislated directly.

Canadians in Puerto Rico

Canadian Cadet Champion Adam Littke finished with 4 out of 9 and placed 28 out of 43. Alexandre Lesiège scored 5.5/9 in the Under 14 group and placed 10th out of 44. Erez Davy scored 3/9 in the Under 10 group, placing 19th out of 21.

The conditions at the tournament were appalling and many competitors complained. The organizers claimed that they had not expected so many entrants (281). The accommodations were filled with unpleasant insects, which does not seem like a problem attributable to the number of participants.
