**2003 World Youth Chess Championships**

This tournament begins on Oct. 22 at the Greek holiday resort of Kallithea, Halkidiki. There is a “ boys “ tournament with groups of U 10, 12, 14, 16 & 18. But girls are able to compete in this section. Humpy Koneru, the young Indian girl sensation is registered in the boys U 16. There is a parallel set of championships for girls only.

997 players from 79 countries are registered ( 593 boys; 404 girls ).

Canada is sending 27 players. In the U 12 Girls, Hazel Smith is ranked 5<sup>th</sup>. In the U 12 Boys, Nikolay Noritsyn is ranked 17<sup>th</sup>.
