Here are the last two games (Kasparov wins Game 3) :

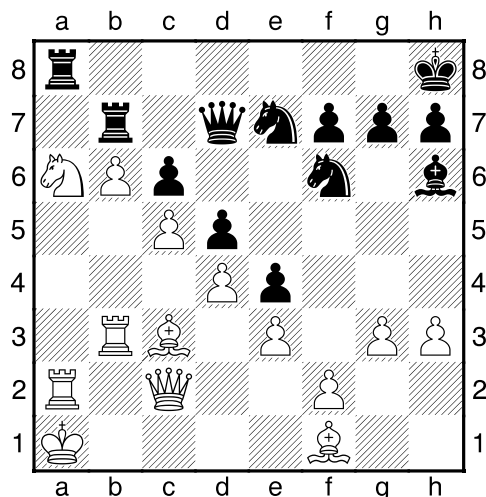
